Role title:	Special Exhibition Steward.

	As none of the works will be on sale, this exhibition will be manned by volunteers only.
	The exhibition will showcase a range of female artists whose work is part of Unilever's private collection, these pieces have never been exhibited publicly together before, until now.
Role description:	 Provide a warm and friendly welcome to our visitors. Assist with visitor orientation and answering general questions about the exhibition. Record visitor numbers. Encourage visitor feedback. Report any cleaning, exhibit maintenance or safety issues to staff. Refer visitors to PSVT Museum or

	have questions/queries that you are unable to answer. Carry out duties in a manner that always reflects PSVT's values. Be a valued member of a friendly, proactive and committed team of staff and volunteers in PSVT's Heritage directorate.

Where:	The exhibition steward role will be based at Bridge Cottage 23 Park Road, Port Sunlight.
When:	The exhibition will be open to the public from: • Saturday 8 th November – 22 nd March. • 11am-3pm
Duration:	This volunteer role will last for 5 months, the duration of the exhibition. Training and induction will be carried out in November before the exhibition opens to the public. You will be able to select from two time slots available for the induction, you only need to attend one. • Monday 3 rd November 10am-11am or 6pm-7pm. Volunteers for this exhibit are required to undertake a minimum of 8 hours a month.
Requirements:	 An interest in the arts. A people person with a flair for good communication. Committed to delivering exceptional customer service. Punctual, reliable and committed. Proactive with a positive and enthusiastic outlook and attitude.

Commitment to you:	 A full induction and training programme will be provided to ensure you are fully supported and equipped to carry out the role. Reasonable travel expenses will be reimbursed, in line with our volunteer expenses policy and procedure.
What's in it for you:	 You will: Be part of a new gallery space that we are developing, representing PSVT's visitor offer. Be part of a friendly and dynamic team. The opportunity to possibly meet the curators and contributors to the exhibition.
